Metal Production Plan for the First Half of FY2021

The metal production plan for the first half of FY2021 of our company, Mitsui Kinzoku (President: NOU Takeshi) is as follows.

1. Zinc (in thousand tons)	109.1	99.6	115.9
2. Lead (in thousand tons)	35.3	33.6	35.9
3. Gold (in tons)	2.7	2.5	2.9
4. Silver (in tons)	108.6	69.2	91.2

(Comparison with figures for the same term in FY2020)

- The reason for the increase in Zinc and Lead production is due to large scale maintenance in Hachinohe Smelting Co., Ltd in the first half of 2020.
- The volume of gold production is due to the difference of raw material grade.
- The reason for the increase in silver production is due to the delay in imported raw materials with high grade silver by COVID-19 influence in FY2020.

(Comparison with figures for second half forecast in FY2020)

- The reason for the decrease in Zinc and Lead production is due to regular maintenance in the first half of 2021.
- The volume of gold production is due to the difference of raw material grade.
- The reason for the increase in silver production is due to the delay in imported raw materials with high grade silver by COVID-19 influence in FY2020.
